

South-East Gymnastics – Setwork Qualifiers 2026

The Setwork Qualifiers 2026 will be held at Meapa GC (Unit B5 & B6 Saxon Place, Medway Valley Park, Rochester, ME2 2NW) on Sunday 20 September. This event will be used to select gymnasts to represent the region at the National Networks Championships.

Take the time to read the BG “National Network Championships” book. Be sure you have the latest version.

Categories

All gymnasts will use the Blakeborough rules (i.e. there is no cap on the total difficulty).

Coaches should inform judges which routine gymnasts will perform at the start of each rotation.

Regional network

We have offered an opportunity to compete “out of age” in previous years. This year, gymnasts may enter a “regional network” category instead.

There will be separate medals for these gymnasts. These gymnasts are not eligible to attend National finals.

Note: the routines are the same for level 1 and level 2. Gymnasts entering the regional set-work in these levels may be eligible to represent the region if there are not enough gymnasts entering the BG network qualifiers to make full teams.

Level 0

Gymnasts 1 year under age (i.e. YoB 2018) may enter “Level 0”. These gymnasts will use the Level 1 rules. These gymnasts are not eligible to attend National finals.

Note: we are not allowed to accept gymnasts younger than this.

Judging requirements

Each club must supply one suitably qualified judge (MAG Regional) for the whole day. The club must pay this judge’s expenses. An under-qualified judge may be used so long as they have gained suitable experience at regional sessions. Clubs who do not supply a judge will be charged to fund a replacement judge from out of the region.

This will not provide enough judges for the event; some clubs will have to provide more than one judge. The region will pay for these extra judges.

Coaches

Please ensure your coaches are qualified at the correct level and they are reminded about dress and jewellery rules.

Audience

The entry fee to this event includes 2 spectator tickets. Spectator tickets will not be available on the door. Please let us know if you think you need more tickets than your allocation.

Entries and dates

Entry to this event will be on-line.

President's Trophy

The President's Trophy is presented to a club (not an individual gymnast) for its performance within the region during the year.

Results from the following regional competitions are counted towards the President's Trophy:

1. Regional Championships: All national levels
2. Regional Setwork Qualifiers: Levels 1-6

The scores from gymnasts placed in the top three of each of these categories are added towards the club total for President's Trophy.

The trophy will be awarded at the end of the last event in the series (Regional Setwork Qualifier).

National Networks Championships

The National Networks Championships will be held on the weekend 30 October - 1 November in Telford. All entries must be done through the region. All gymnasts will compete as individuals and as part of a team.

The region intends to send one team in each category. Each team can contain up to 6 gymnasts.

There will be a participation fee for all gymnasts competing at the Setwork finals. This fee will be set after the qualifiers, once we know who will enter the finals. It will be in the order of £50.00 per gymnast. This participation fee includes the cost of clothing hire, regional training, coaches' expenses and the entry fee to the competition itself.

Team selection will be decided at a meeting at the end of the qualification day.

Blakeborough / Currier selection

In general, the top 6 in each category will make the team for the Blakeborough trophy, the next 6 will make up the team for the Currier trophy.

If a gymnast would be better placed in either Blakeborough or Currier at finals, please indicate that preference on the entry.

Gymnasts will be able to switch from one stream to the other after the qualification. Gymnasts do not need to adhere to the start score cap if they have indicated a preference for "Currier".

Regional training

All gymnasts entering National Networks Championships are expected to attend regional training. There will be one session this year for all gymnasts. This session will be all day on Sunday 25 October at Hawth GC. We will fix an appropriate timetable for this session once we know the timetable for the national finals, which gymnasts will compete, and which coaches will attend.

Clothing sizes

Please ensure Simon Gale (Tolworth) knows the clothing sizes for any boys and coaches going to the National Finals. This clothing will comprise: leotard, shorts, longs, tracksuit trousers, tracksuit jacket, T shirt. We will guess your clothing sizes if you have not placed an order.

The MA teams have consistently lost items of clothing in past years. Each club is responsible for ordering all clothing their gymnasts need. The club will be responsible for ensuring all those items are returned at the end of the weekend.
